



WHAT IS MY RING SIZE?

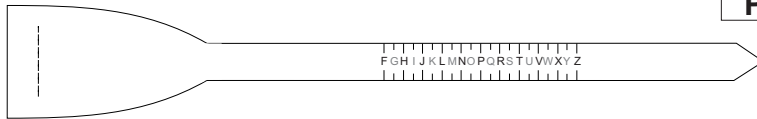
Here are some easy steps to find out what your size is!

The paper size

- Carefully cut out the size.
Fold a end and cut slit.
- Wrap around finger. This should be done at the end of the day (as your finger is bigger then)
- Slide the pointed end, through the slit.
- Pull tightly, it must be snug to produce an accurate size.
- Move to the largest part of your finger. (this may be your knuckle)
- The number that lines up with the slit is your size.

Circumference (Size in Millimeters)

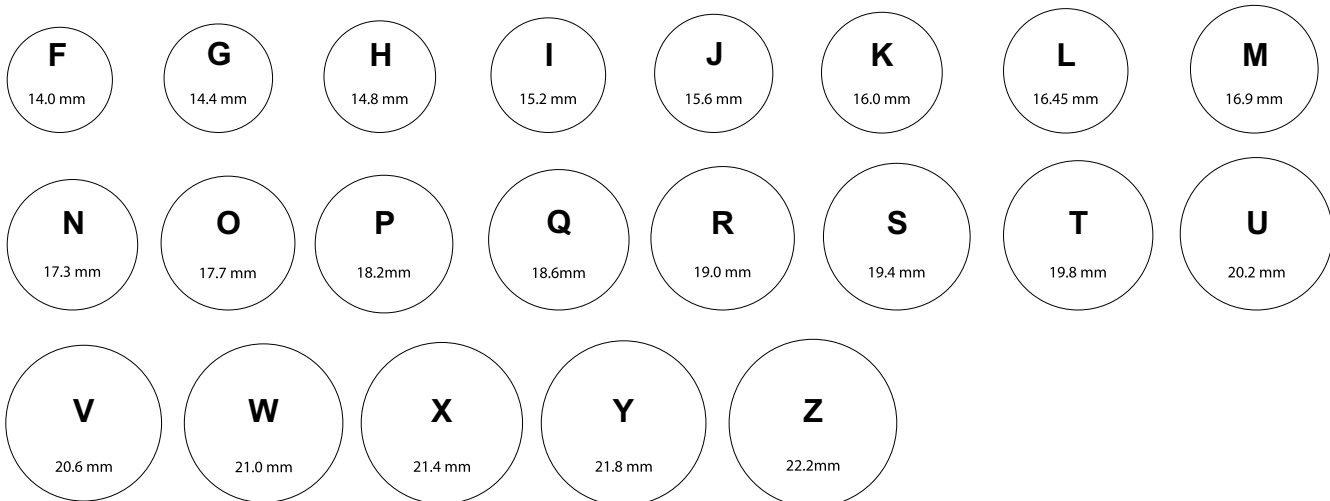

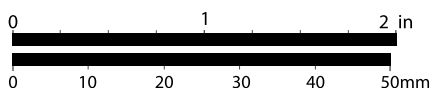
The Diameter sizer

- Find a ring that fits the finger the ring is intended for
- Place the ring over the circle below.
- Match the **INSIDE** edge of the ring to the appropriate circle.
- If your ring is between 2 sizes, order the bigger size.

CONFIRM THAT YOU PRINTED TO SIZE
 MAKE SURE THIS MEASURES UP.



- PRIOR TO PRINTING, ENSURE THAT PAGE SCALING IS SET TO "NONE" ON YOUR PRINT DIALOG BOX.
- MEASURE THE BAR ON THE LEFT TO ENSURE IT IS EXACTLY 2 INCHES, OR 50 MM LONG.
- IF MEASUREMENT IS NOT ACCURATE, CHECK THAT YOU ARE PRINTING THE PAGE AT FULL SIZE AND REPRINT BEFORE CONTINUING.**
